PARIS CHRISTMAS PRE-DEPARTURE INFORMATION 2011

Thank you for choosing to holiday with Topdeck. We certainly appreciate your decision to travel with us and rest assured everyone at Topdeck will be doing their utmost to ensure you have the holiday of a lifetime.

We have prepared the following information for you which we trust will assist you in planning for your trip. Some points should be taken as a guide only such as personal spending money, which can vary greatly between individuals but we are sure you will find the information in general very useful.

Baggage

We recommend frameless backpacks, plus a small day pack or carry bag. Remember, if you take too much, you have to carry it around before and after the trip! **Please limit your baggage allowance to a maximum of 20kgs.** Maximum allowable size for all bags must not exceed 70cm x 50cm x 25cm. Please note that due to space and weight restrictions on our coaches, passengers with too much luggage on departure morning in London may be told that they cannot take their entire luggage with them. Luggage storage facilities are available at the Clink hostel. Any luggage left behind will be at your own risk and you will be required to pay any cost that is incurred. Please keep in mind you are staying in multi-share hotel accommodation, and luggage space in the rooms is not extensive

Suggested Clothing List

The following clothing list is suggested based on our experience. The basic rule however is "pack light". Our passengers invariably state they wished they had brought half the amount of clothes and remember you are bound to find items to purchase on your trip so leave room for additional purchases during your holiday. Please ensure your bag weight doesn't go over 20kg at the end of the trip not the beginning!!

- Smart casual evening wear
- 1 pairs of jeans / trousers
- 1 pair of walking shoes
- 1 sweater / jumper
- 1 warm jacket / coat
- 2 shirts / t-shirts / long-sleeved shirts
- 1 rainproof jacket
- 1 pair of shoes (smart/casual)
- Underwear and socks
- Hat, scarf, gloves

General

- Basic medical kit (inc. aspirins, plasters)
- Towel
- Sewing kit
- Toiletries

Visa and Passport Information

Please make sure your passport is valid for at least 6 months after the last day of your trip. Some countries will refuse entry if there is not at least 6 months validity on passports after your departure date from their country. Depending on your nationality, you may require a visa to enter certain countries. **It is your responsibility to obtain these prior to the departure of the trip.** Consult your agent to determine which visas you will require.

We also have a visa chart on our website listing the visas required by some nationalities travelling on our trips. To check go to our website www.topdecktravel.co.uk, click on to Travelling with Topdeck and then Visa Information.

Remember that some visas can take up to six weeks to obtain, so do not leave it until the last minute. Also bear in mind that the validity of the visa often runs from the date of issue rather than date of entry into the country. Please check with the appropriate embassies prior to departure as requirements do change periodically.

Multiple Entry Visas

Certain trips or your personal travel arrangements may require multiple entry visas. Please check your itinerary for the correct port of entry / exit for your trip.

SCHENGEN AGREEMENT:

France, Italy, Austria, Germany, the Netherlands, Portugal, Luxembourg, Greece, Spain, Belgium, Denmark, Finland, Iceland, Norway, Sweden are all part of the Schengen Agreement, which means that one visa can be used to cover all of these countries. If you need a visa for any of these countries that your trip visits, **you may require a multi-entry Schengen visa**. The country you will be spending the most time in usually issues the Schengen visa.

Note that all trips departing and returning to London; under normal circumstances, **enter and exit continental Europe and the Schengen area through Calais in France**. Please check your itinerary for the correct port of entry / exit for your trip.

Insurance

It is **compulsory** for all passengers to take out comprehensive travel insurance before the trip departs covering cancellation, medical expenses including repatriation, loss or damage to baggage and personal belongings, money and public liability. Topdeck can issue travel insurance, please refer to our website www.topdeck.travel, click on 'Travelling with Topdeck' and then 'Travel Advice' for more information. You must bring a copy of your travel insurance policy with you on the trip.

Your Trip Leader will make a record of your basic travel insurance details at the start of your trip, e.g. the name of the insurance company, the 24 hour emergency telephone number, and your policy number. These will be faxed back to our London office to ensure that if you lose your policy details, they can be easily retrieved.

Health & Vaccinations

If you suffer from any kind of medical condition you must advise Topdeck at the time of booking, or at least six weeks prior to the departure of your trip. No vaccinations are currently compulsory for entry into European countries. Please reconfirm this before you leave as conditions could change.

If you require regular medication, you must have an ample supply of medication before your trip departs, as it can be difficult to obtain in some countries. You must be able to administer your own medication, as Topdeck Road Crew will not be able to administer it, and there are no guarantees that there will be anyone with first aid training on board.

Spending Money

Automatic Teller Machines (ATMs) are available all over France and are the safest and easiest way to have access to cash. Travellers' cheques are also accepted in France and are an alternative to using ATMs, however if your trip is over a weekend or public holiday you may find it difficult to cash your travellers' cheques. The Euro (€) is the currency used in France. We recommend at least €50-€60 Euros per day to cover your normal expenses. If you wish to purchase expensive souvenirs, you will need to budget for more, or use your credit cards for these purchases. Remember, this is a *guideline* figure and can vary greatly between individuals according to your overall personal budget and spending habits!

Credit Cards

Most well known credit cards are accepted in France. We recommend that you bring yours along in case you see something special, which you haven't budgeted for. Credit cards **CANNOT** be used for optional excursions.

Optional Activities

On most trips we have arranged extra activities that we think will enhance your travel experience, but you have a choice as to whether or not you will participate. These are called Optional Excursions and are not included in the cost of your trip. They are usually organised on a group participation basis and should be taken into consideration when budgeting your spending money.

None of the optional excursions on your trip are operated by Topdeck, and nor do they form part of your contract with Topdeck for your trip. Topdeck arranges optional excursions as an Agent of the local supplier. Should you participate in any optional excursions your contract will be with the local supplier of the excursion, and their conditions will apply. We have selected all of these operators based on recommendations from past passengers and Topdeck Road Crew.

Claim Your Free Topdeck Global Sim Card Before You Leave for Your Trip

All our travellers are entitled to claim a free TopDeck global SIM card to use while on their Topdeck trip! Just follow this link to claim yours: www.topdeck.ekit.com/freesim - use your Topdeck "Booking Reference" and purchase a minimum of \$20 calling credit.

The Topdeck SIM is a "roaming free" SIM card just drop it into your mobile and enjoy savings of up to 90% on calls while travelling throughout Europe.

Every SIM card includes the ekit Travel Journal. The Travel Journal automatically updates your location to Google maps on a daily basis. This allows you to keep track of where you've been, and with the option to publish this on facebook and twitter you can easily show-off your

travels to friends and family. Not only does this provide a hassle free way of keeping in contact, but you can text in your own journal updates or photos for an even more detailed record of your holiday!

Departing on Your Trip

Our London departure point for your Paris Christmas trip is:

Clink 78 Hostel, 78 Kings Cross Road, London, WC1X 9QG.

Here are a few directions to help you on your arrival.

From London Airports:

Heathrow Airport is connected to the entire Greater London area by the capital's underground railway network. From passport control and baggage reclaim follow the "Underground" signs to the underground station. Take the Piccadilly Line (colour coded dark blue) to Kings Cross station. When leaving the station take any exit and ensure that Euston Road is in front of you and that the King's Cross and St. Pancras stations are behind you. Turn left and walk down Euston Road, Euston Road then turns into Pentonville Road. Walk down this road and the 2nd street on your right is King's Cross Road. Take this road and as it curves around to the right you will see a big Travelodge hotel on your left. The Clink is a former courthouse located directly after this hotel. Walking time is 10 minutes.

Gatwick Airport is not connected to the underground system. By overland rail, First Capital Connect trains take you directly to St. Pancras station. Once at St. Pancras station follow the directions above.

If you are going to be in London for a few days, it will be cheaper for you to buy an **Oyster Card** on arrival. This will give you savings on all London's public transport for the length of your stay.

If You Miss the Departure in London – What To Do!

Firstly ring our emergency number +44 77 9277 5415 and our staff can advise you what to do next.

If you happen to miss your coach, trips leaving from London travel to Dover where they catch a ferry to Calais, and then drive to our Paris hotel, called B&B La Villette, 4 Rue Emile Reynaud, 75019 Paris. To get to the hotel, you can catch the Eurostar train direct from St Pancras Station to Gare du Nord station in Paris. From the Gare du Nord station, you must transfer on to Line 5 (direction Bobigny Pablo Picasso), travel one stop to Stalingrad, then transfer onto Line 7 (direction La Courneuve 8 Mai 1945) and travel four stops to Porte de la Villette. Take the exit and turn left onto Boulevard MacDonalds, turn right onto Avenue Corentin Cariou, continue towards Avenue de la Porte de la Villette. Turn left and stay on Avenue de la Porte de la Villette, at the roundabout take the first exit on Boulevard de la Commanderie, turn right onto rue Emile Reynaud. Walking time is about 10 minutes.

Finishing your trip

All trips ending in London finish at the Clink Hostel, Kings Cross. Your Paris Christmas trip should finish at approximately 9.00pm. Please be aware that delays often occur during the Christmas and New Year period either on the motorways coming towards Calais or at UK Immigration. If this happens and we miss our normal ferry from Calais to Dover, your arrival time back in London could be delayed up to several hours. Therefore we strongly recommend that you do not book flights out of London on the night your trip finishes.

Accommodation

Your Paris Christmas trip will stay at in multi-share hotel accommodation. The number of people in a room varies, however rooms in the hostel are usually 2-4 bedded rooms. Please be aware that this trip operates a single sex policy and therefore couples should not expect to share together.

Meals

Breakfasts are included every day (except the first morning). Other meals are included as detailed in the trip itinerary. Many lunches and dinners are not included, so that you can take full advantage of the variety of food available in France. If you have special dietary requirements e.g. vegetarian or wheat intolerance, we will make every endeavour to cater to your specific needs as long as you advise your agent or reservations when you book.

Toilets

In most European countries you will have to pay a small amount to use public toilets at service stations and in city centres. It is a common practice in Europe and should be regarded as a form of 'tipping', as the money goes to the people who clean and/or maintain the facilities. It is very rare that public toilets do not supply toilet paper, but it may be useful to carry a pack of tissues with you.
